Parallel Session 3.5 - Re-Integration of Migrant Women Workers Through Entrepreneurship and Financial Literacy

Maria Angela Villalba is Unlad Kabayan's founder and Executive Director. She previously worked in Hong Kong as a consultant. Her involvement with migrant issues led her to create the Asian Migrant Centre, a regional NGO in Hong Kong, in 1989. She is a board member of Global Fund for Women, a founder of Migrant Forum in Asia, and a founding executive council member of Migrants Rights International. In 2007, she received the Social Entrepreneur award in the Philippines from Ernst and Young and SGV Foundation.

Mr. Anders Lisborg is currently a Programme Officer for the International Labour Organization (ILO) at the Regional Office for Asia and Pacific, in Bangkok, Thailand. He has for more than a decade been working on issues related to irregular migration, human trafficking, smuggling, and labour exploitation - both in Europe and Asia. As a part of his current position he is managing a reintegration project for returned victims of trafficking in Thailand and the Philippines.

Doris Magsaysay-Ho is President and CEO of the Magsaysay Group of Companies, which is involved in shipping, human resources and Business Process Outsourcing services. Established in the Philippines in 1948, Magsaysay expanded from its roots in shipping to people resource providers. Magsaysay is present in the Philippines, Indonesia, Thailand, China, Eastern Europe, Central America and North America. The company prepares its people for a diverse range of positions for the maritime, cruise, healthcare, hospitality, engineering and other industries. Its shipping arm, Magsaysay Transport and Logistics Group, operates in the Philippine trade with container liner and tanker services. Its affiliate, Fairmont Shipping Limited, based in Hongkong, Vancouver and London, operates in the dry bulk trade. Guided by its principles of caring for people and investing in training, Magsaysay has been twice awarded by Lloyd's List Maritime Asia as Manning Agent of the Year, in 2005 and 2006.
